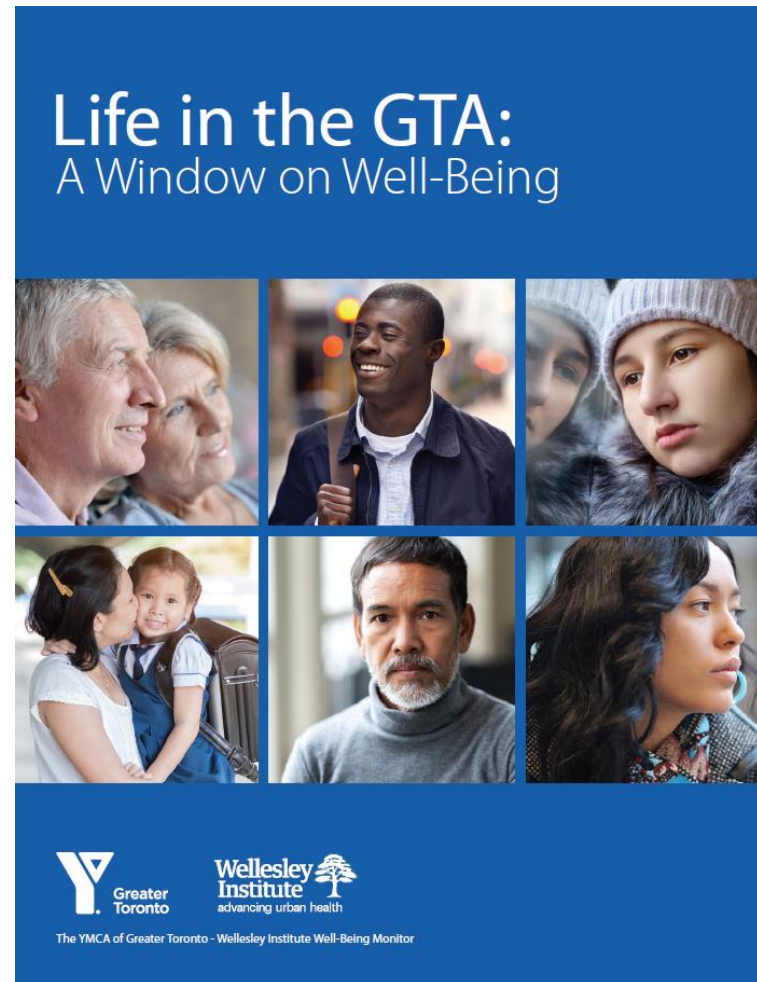

- Telephone survey, collected Nov 9th to Dec 21st, 2017.
- Total: 8270; 7 per census tract
- Measurement focus: wellbeing



The Social Capital Study

- Collected: March 12th to July 10th, 2018
- 3207 City of Toronto residents
- Measurement focus: social-relational factors

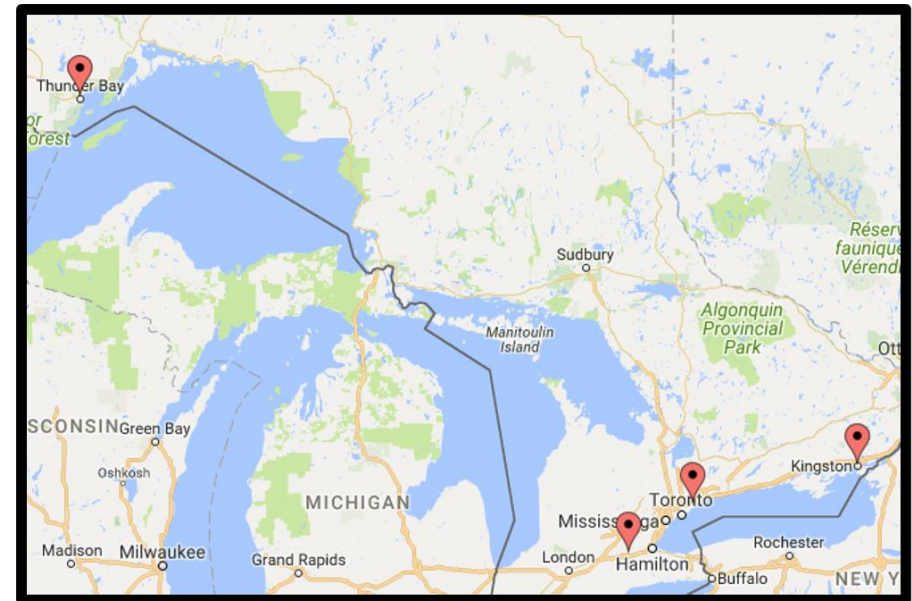
